SKENARIO PBL3

In 2014, the Indonesian government has launched a National Health Insurance (NHI). Health care system in the Indonesia NHI is divided into three levels of services, that is primary care level, the secondary level (specialist) and tertiary level (sub-specialist) which is used DRG system (Diagnose Related Group). The DRG for NHI its called INA CBGs (Indonesian Case Based Groups) and Indonesian casemix which derived from data coding and data costing. Tariff fees are formed based on grouping of diagnoses and procedures related to the treatment costs. Each group has similar clinical characteristics, similar use of resources, and similar use of treatment costs. The purpose of implementing INA CBGs is to improve the efficiency of health financing and to improve the quality of health services. Based on the evaluation in 2019, the INA CBGs should be modified and need reclassification, which is the process of re-grouping the diagnosis and procedures of the current grouper to fit the existing conditions. Therefore, the Indonesian Dental Association established a task force to compile a dental disease code, use clinical pathways and calculate the cost of the necessary treatment for outpatient and inpatient care.
