In semester 4, we conducted a phase 1 study to look at the characteristics of patients and patient companions. We also measured the level of knowledge, life burden, and stress scale. The study took from mid-March to the end of May, which found 75 patients and is currently in data analysis. The research continued to prepare materials for group discussion forums in the form of forms and guidelines. The Group Forum Discussion (FGD) was held on July 8, 2023, by forming two groups of health workers and patient companions to determine the needs and information needed by each user (patient, companion, and health worker) during dementia care. Then it will continue to test the application so that it can be prepared for further research in August.

For non-academic activities, participate in seminar activities in Malaysia in June 2023 for knowledge enrichment and in seminar committees held by the Indonesian Pharmacist Association.

In this 5th semester, stage 3 of the research will be carried out, namely testing the use of the application, which was previously validated by professional judgment and carried out a usability test.
