 Directing means encouraging subordinates to work toward achieving company objectives







 It is the human-people to people aspect of managing by which subordinates are motivated, persuaded and led to effectively and efficiently contribute towards realizing the very reasons for which the enterprise or the company has been established.







• Directing is about the actuation of the methods to work efficiently to achieve

the set organizational objectives.

## Nursing Manager Activities in Directing Function

- Giving directions is the first activity and suggests that directions should be clear, concise and consistent and should confirm to the requirements of the situation.
- Supervising is concerned with the training and discipline of the work force. It also includes follow up to ensure the prompt execution of orders.
- Leading is the ability to inspire and to influence others t the attainment of objectives





## Nursing Manager Activities in Directing Function

- Motivating is the set of skills the manager uses to help the employee to identify his/her needs and finds ways within the organization to help satisfy them.
- Communicating: involves the what, how, by whom, and why of directives or effectively using the communication process.






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
