## SCENARIO 3 BLOK ALIMENTARY

An 18-month-old child is brought to an emergency unit because of frequent stools and vomiting. The symptoms have been present for 3 days. Her mother describes stools as watery, and with no mucous or blood. She is reportedly unable to keep anything down, vomiting after every feeding, even water. She has about 6 episodes of diarrhea and 4 episodes of vomiting per day. She attends daycare when she is well.

On the physical examination, she is somnolent, tachycardia, the distal of her extremities are cold, and the skin turgo*r* is diminished. The attending physician administers plan C rehydration and will consider giving antibiotic and zinc.
